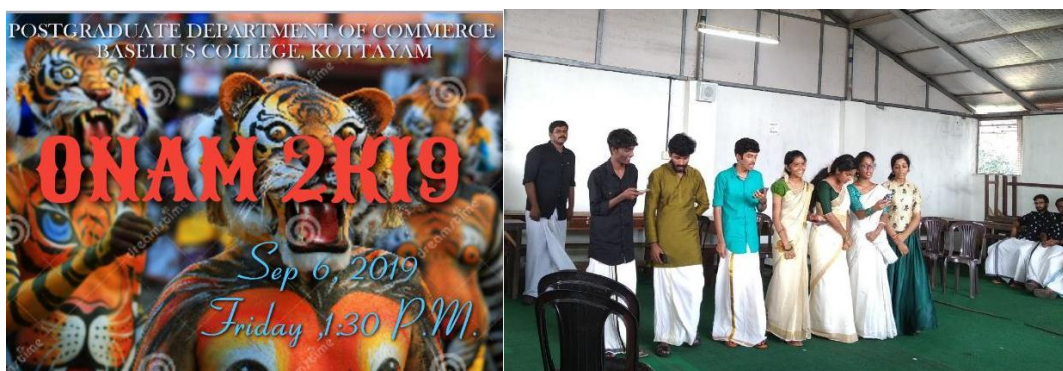
3. Teachers Day Celebration


9. Tutelage Lecture Series
