REPORT OF SCHOLAR SUPPORT PROGRAMME 2018-2019

Scholar Support Programme for the academic year 2018-2019 offered and imparted only for the selected students of first year UG Programme. Selection of students and theme/area for internal mentoring were done as per the guidelines insisted by Office of New Initiatives, Collegiate education, Dept. of Higher Education Kerala.

Selection of students for the first year Scholar Support Programme was completed by 25/09/2018. Subjects selected for internal mentoring of first year Scholar Support Programme includes English, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Accountancy and Statistics. Internal mentoring classes for the first year students were officially started in the month of November and external mentoring classes on 25 January 2019.

WORKSHOPS ATTENDED

 The SSP Coordinator designated by the college council has attended the workshop conducted at Loyola College Trivandrum on 12/09/2018 to discuss the implementation of SSP in the aided Arts and Science colleges during the academic year 2018 -2019.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES.

1. INTERNAL MENTORING

This is for supporting the students in any one of the subject of their study. Here mentoring is given to slow learners of selected subjects by the teachers in the subjects to motivate and bring them to the main stream. All the activities aim to strengthen the students and improve their confidence to face the university exams. Following methods of teaching learning were put into practice for conducting the same.

- Personal discussions with students to know about their issues, weakness and strengths.
- Motivational talks were conducted with students to make them aware of the possibilities and opportunities in the field of their study.
- Portions of the subjects that students feel difficult were individually dealt with .

- More exercises and question papers are provided to students to familiarize them with University question pattern.
- Exercises for learning as well as question papers are prepared and provided to them
 by the teachers based on previous university question pattern.
- Test papers of short time duration were conducted to assess the progress of students in subjects concerned.

The subject mentoring sessions for English (Common Papers) for first and second semester students were conducted by Dr. Dona Elizabeth, UGC FDP Substitute, Department of English from 27.11.2018 to 11.12..2018 (Sem. 1; 7 sessions) and 121.2019 to12.02.2019 (Sem 2; 7 sessions). The subject mentoring sessions for the Physics complementary papers for the first and second semester students of Mathematics were conducted by Dr. Aparna Thankappan, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Physics of this college from 15.11.2018 to 20.12.2018 (sem. 1; 7 sessions) and 19.12.2019 to 22.02.2019 (Sem 2; 7 sessions). The subject mentoring sessions for Mathematics complementary papers of first and second semester B.Sc Chemistry and Physics students were conducted by Smt. Tessymol Abraham, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Mathematics from 24.11.2018 to 08.12.2018 (sem. 1; 7 sessions) and 16.02.2019 to 21.02.2019 (Sem. 2; 7 sessions). The subject mentoring sessions for the Chemistry Complementary papers of the first and second semester B.Sc Botany and Zoology Students were conducted by Smt. Shetal Elizabeth Thomas, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Chemistry of this college from 13.11.2018 to 22.11.2018 (sem. 1; 7 sessions) and 14.02.2019 to 22.02.2019 (Sem 2; 7 sessions). The subject mentoring sessions for first and second semester B.B.A students in the Accountancy and Statistics were conducted by Mr. Richu Mathew, UGC FDP Substitute, Dept. of Commerce of this college from 10.11.2018 to 06.12.2018 (sem. 1; 7 sessions) and 11.02.2019 to 23.02.2019 (Sem 2; 7 sessions).

2. LEARNING SKILL CLASSES

As per the SSP guidelines learning skill classes (4 Hours) were arranged for all students selected for SSP in two different sessions on different days 25/01/19 and 25/02/2019
