Jaivam 2017 is a Mahatma Gandhi University initiative to spread of organic farming in Kottayam. The initiative included campaign for transforming Kottayam District into a 100% Literacy District in organic farming.

The ambitious project being implemented through National Service Scheme (NSS) was launched formally by Honorable Chief Minister Sri.
